The Marist College Liberty Partnerships Program (LPP) provides comprehensive services to meet the academic, social, emotional, and career needs of students in their programs.

One hundred seventy Middle School students are participating in the Marist College Liberty Partnership program this year at the Middle School. To teach students money management skills as well as to incentivise them to complete their academic work, after students finish all their work, they earn Marist Bucks. At the end of every month, students buy different items from the marist "store" using their earned bucks. Students learn to budget their earned "cash" and to make smart purchasing decisions.



High School: College and Career Exploration, Planning and Development

Our District is no longer using Naviance, the college application and search platform and has moved over to Schoolinks. This new platform supports The Entire Student Planning Journey Within a Single Platform. This platform not only supports the needs of students interested in attending college but also those whose post secondary interests may be joining the workforce. Students can also search for summer internships, part time and summer jobs. Schoolinks closely aligns with the District's Transformation Pathways Initiative and the District's focus on data informed practices.

The District has purchased 3 Flight Simulators and 3 Rudder Controls, which control the movement of an aircraft about its vertical axis!



When you hear "this is your captain speaking" on an airline flight in the United States, more than 90% of the time, the speaker is a white male. Just 3.4% of U.S. airline pilots are Black, 2.2% are of Asian descent, and a paltry 0.5% are Hispanic or Latino. Women make up just 4.6%. As the U.S. population trends to greater racial and ethnic diversity, airline pilots look less like their passengers.
